



Are you interested in . . .

Confirmation? Reception? Reaffirmation?

Plans are being made to offer a series of intergenerational gatherings to read, journal, pray and discuss using this Episcopal Church curriculum for both young people and adults who may be seeking to be confirmed or received into the Episcopal church, or who may be drawn to reaffirm their own confirmation as a lifelong learner in our faith.

The curriculum consists of six two-hour sessions covering the Apostle's Creed and the five promises which make up the covenant with God which was entered into at our baptism, and which we read each Sunday to remind ourselves of our part in that covenant.

The details of when the gatherings will take place, and when we'll be with the bishop to hold the confirmation/reception/reaffirmation service have not been determined yet. However, this is the first step: identifying those within the congregation—from teens to adults of any age—who might be interested in pursuing this learning opportunity. The decision to actually be confirmed or received can be made later.
