

BARRELS FOR HAITI



For the 14th consecutive year we are collecting items to send to The Sisters of the Society of St. Margaret in Port-au-Prince, Haiti. See the list below for suggested items. We also need money to cover the cost of buying and shipping the barrels, which is now \$200 per barrel. We are using more expensive plastic barrels because they can be repurposed to collect rainwater. Checks should be written to Church of the Holy Trinity with **Haiti Project** on the memo line.

The Sisters' Wish List

- ◊ **Food: especially brown and white rice and dried beans.** Canned meats, canned tomato products, powdered milk, peanut butter, corn meal, white and brown sugar, cocoa, coffee, tea bags, cooking oil, especially olive oil, and flour. Cereals.
- ◊ **Shoes and sneakers in good condition for school age children.**
- ◊ **All sizes of batteries because electricity is very rare.**
- ◊ **Other Items:** deodorant, personal toiletries, tooth brushes and tooth paste, hair brushes and combs, first aid supplies, aspirin, wash cloths and bath towels, soap, bedding. Office supplies, school supplies, new and used candles, trash and Ziploc bags, any size. All other donations are welcome, but no winter clothes, please.

The Barrels will be in the Narthex and inside the Union Street door up until Easter.

The Sisters and those to whom they minister are extremely grateful for your prayers and your generosity.
