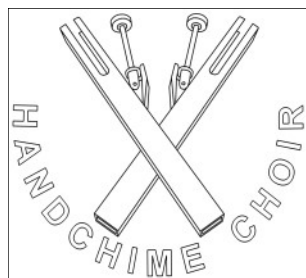


**THE WAY OF LOVE**
